NILA is a computer-based assessment focusing on Listening, Reading and Writing.

The NILA Parent Report for your child:

- ✿ includes statements describing the key aspects that have been assessed;
- ✿ shows what NILA identified your child:
 - was able to do;
 - was beginning to do; or
 - may need help to do; and
- ✿ uses coloured circles to indicate whether the statement describes an aspect of the Literacy Curriculum that is:



**above what is expected in
your child's curriculum year;**



**within what is expected in
your child's curriculum year; or**



**below what is expected in
your child's curriculum year.**



Remember that the NILA Parent Report reflects how your child answered on a particular day. It is important that you discuss the contents of this report with your child's teacher.
