On behalf of all our patients and field staff in the Philippines, thank you very much for holding your book sale and raising an incredible £442.50 for Médecins Sans Frontières' emergency response to Typhoon Haiyan. What a fantastic achievement!

## Your fundraising in action

Our first emergency medical teams were on the ground within 24 hours. With your help, we have managed to get hundreds of tonnes of medical and emergency relief supplies into the country.

We now have over 200 staff in the Philippines, including doctors, nurses, water and sanitation experts and psychologists providing emergency medical assistance to people who have lost everything.



Our teams are providing urgent medical care in Guiuan on Samar island, in Tacloban, Ormoc and Burauen on Leyte island and the area around Roxas and Estancia on Panay Island.

In Tacloban, Médecins Sans Frontières teams constructed an inflatable hospital on the grounds of the city hospital that was destroyed. This is providing the community with essential medical services, such as an operating theatre, a maternity delivery room and a blood bank.

Thanks to people like you, our doctors are able to respond at a moment's notice when humanitarian emergencies like Typhoon Haiyan occur. We are currently treating hundreds of patients every day in the Philippines and we will continue to do so because of your help.
